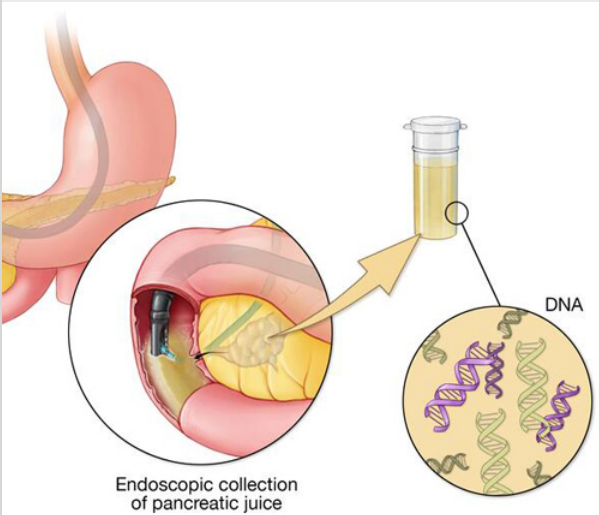

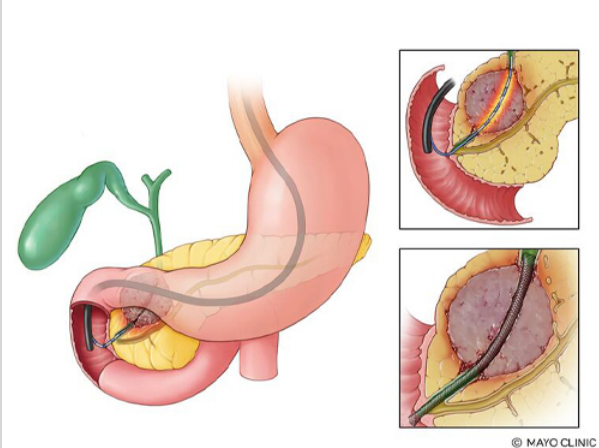

A combination of methylated DNA biomarkers in pancreatic juice and plasma carbohydrate antigen 19-9 detected pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma with higher accuracy compared to either stand-alone.

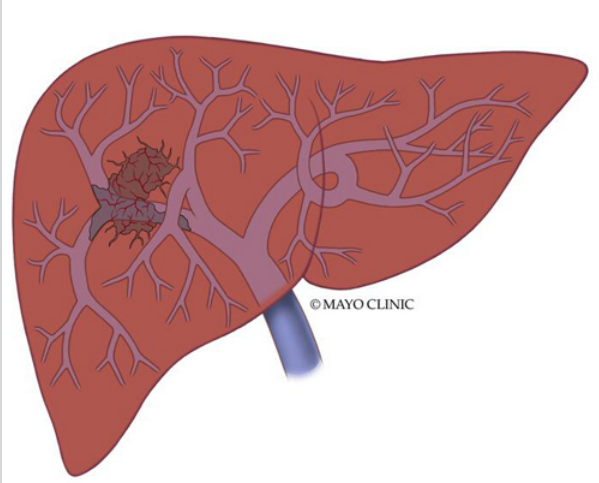

The tool is designed to assist cytologists in the evaluation of digital whole-slide images generated from bile duct brushing specimens.

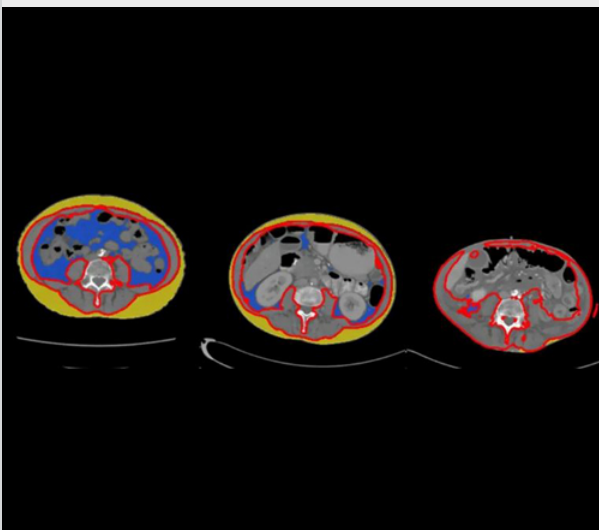
